### A BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN FORT WAYNE THAT OFFERS UNPRECEDENTED ACCESS TO PROMINENT NATIONAL AND LOCAL LEADERS

The Mad Ants invite all business professionals from the Fort Wayne area to join the 2011-12 Mad Ants Business Forum, a business development group centered around a speaker series of prominent national and local leaders. The Business Forum, now in its second year, is unique in its ability to give its members access to a stellar lineup of company presidents, CEOs, and leaders, and its monthly meetings will offer six opportunities to hear and meet top minds in fields like law, real estate, communications, and sports business.

Membership in this group will also allow members to network with peers and speakers before these sessions and during Mad Ants home basketball games, where all members have season tickets on the floor in the seats of our Ant Colony.

Businesses may purchase company memberships, which are assigned to the business instead of an individual. These memberships give any employee of that company the opportunity to attend the program's events.
